Jessica has been a featured speaker for the Texas Education Agency in Austin and Richardson, Texas.

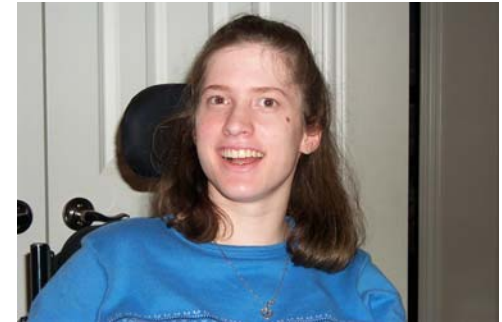
Jessica has given presentations to students on the life of a disabled student. Additionally, she has participated on panels to help educators understand inclusion.
